The International Association of History Museums is organising a visit and discussion for museum professionals to the **MUSÉE D'HISTOIRE DE MARSEILLE, 2, rue Henri-Barbusse**. All IAMH members are invited to participate.

This visit is in continuation of the very successful previous such visits by our Association to: *House of Terror Museum* (Budapest 2005), *Museu d'Historia de Catalunya* (Barcelona 2007), *Musée International de la Réforme* (Geneva 2008), *STAM City Museum* (Ghent 2009), *Musée Gadagne* (Lyon 2010), *Historisches Museum* (Luzern 2011), *Historisches Museum* (Basel 2012), *Museum aan de Stroom* (Antwerp 2014), *National Historical Museum* (Athens 2015), *Museo del Risorgimento* (Milan 2016), the *Historical Museum of Serbia & Museum of Yugoslavia* (Belgrade 2017) and the *Musée Historique* (Lausanne 2018).



- Next to the « Vieux-Port » and to the archeological site « la Bourse - Port Antique », the Historical Museum of Marseille allows you to discover not less than 26 centuries of urban history. Completely renewed in 2013, it is among the biggest history museums in Europe with a 3500 m2 permanent exhibition with 4000 objects, as well as a space dedicated to temporary exhibitions, a room for workshops, a 200 places auditorium and a documentation center.

- The museum tour is organized according to two major themes: the oldest French city; a port city opened on the Mediterranean Sea. The visitor will discover the city history thanks to a maritime thread which binds 13 chronological segments, from the first prehistoric occupations to the modern urban developments. Each segment is organized around a distinctive object.
- Beyond the walls, the museum offers a tour through the Old Marseille from east to west.

We express our gratitude to the Musée d'Histoire de Marseille for inviting us and for organising the event in cooperation with the Association.
